

Broadmoor Christmas Parade Staging Map



Blue Arrows = parade staging area entry and exit for parade.


Orange Arrows = parade return route.

The school's address is 10100 Goodwood Boulevard.

Enter the staging area from the east bound lane of Goodwood Boulevard, using entrance **#1. #2** – Check in station. **#3 & #4** - Cars dropping people off are to drop off at area #3 and then exit through the #4 exit. If you are just dropping off, do not go into the A, B, or C areas. **A & B** – Vehicles, floats, bikes, etc. that will be <u>in the parade</u> will park in rows **A** and **B**. **C** – Vehicles that will not be in parade will park in the **C** area. **D** – Due to tight turns in the staging area, **extra large floats** (i.e. longer than 30') should come down/up Sharp Road, turn onto Browning Drive, take Browning all the way until it dead ends on South Woodhaven, turn right and park on the school side of the street next to the parking areas. The first large float to arrive parks near the #4 exit/entrance. When the parade returns, park on South Woodhaven Street again. **E** – Staging area for groups that do not have a vehicle or float. **#5** - Parade vehicles/ floats, and personal cars etc. will exit through the **#5** exit. Parade will return to the parking lot through the **#4** exit/entrance.







